GOALS

As Reform universities, we are dedicated to offer the most **innovative learning offer** to all our ERUA students.

ERUA's third field of action is focused on building **a new ecosystem** within the alliance by combining our respective teaching offer and the successful experiments conducted by the ERUA's working group on "Re-imagining Higher Education and Research". All our activities are developed through an **innovative integrated framework** thanks to the active participation of all the ERUA team from all member universities.

MEASURES

- Develop a common conceptual and digital approach to education and research;
- Develop a deep disciplinary knowledge and foster interdisciplinarity;
- Enable students to design their own learning pathways through uniquely flexible combinations of courses. We foster experience-based learning through civic engagement, critical thinking and interdisciplinarity. Our activities involve all fields of study and all levels of study (Bachelor, Master and Doctoral levels). Our main objective is to make our learning offer the most accessible to all our ERUA students. Therefore, we are engaged in fostering inclusion and overcoming the obstacles for physical mobility (due to socio-economic background, lack of time, job obligations, financial reasons, etc.) through implementing for instance more short term mobilities and blended learning. ERUA will offer a wide range of learning opportunities. We are already engaged in offering two opportunities for our students and our teachers:
 - → ERUA INTENSIVE COURSES
 - → ERUA TRAVELLING SEMINARS

ERUA is working hand-in-hand with its academic community to bring the best solutions to our future generations of European citizens.

FIRST YEAR REPORT OF PROGRESS

- The main activities carried out concerned the implementation of Intensive Courses, Travelling Seminars and Joint Programmes;
- Preparation of a mapping of all short-format courses in the partner universities;
- Catalogue with available courses for the alliance's students was published twice, in May and October 2021:
- The first student mobilities took place during the summer and are continuing through the academic year;
- Raise awareness among teaching staff and students with information sessions and relative articles;
- Regular update of the ERUA educational offer through the adapted ERUA website;
- Open call for Travelling Seminars launched in spring 2021 and announcement of results in July;
- Preparatory work for joint programmes (research on important definitions, national legislation and already existing joint programmes in the partner universities);
- The charter for common framework will unite the partners' vision for joint programmes;

WHAT'S NEXT?

- The ERUA charter for joint programmes and a mapping for the relevant fields of cooperation will be finalised in the following months;
- Aim to continue offering opportunities of Intensive Programmes to students throughout the year;
- Set the **open calls for Travelling Seminars** on a yearly schedule;
- The establishment of a service learning center and the charter for self-made pathways are the next tasks the WP3 Board will be working on.













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
