Featuring a highly interdisciplinary topic that combines all social sciences and humanities, we welcome intensive course proposals from all disciplines. We are also open to new and innovative teaching formats including co-teaching, hybrid or virtual teaching, film screenings, panel discussions, ted talks etc.

The Winter School an initiative of ERUA, the European Reform University Alliance, and will be held from February 24th 2023 to March 3rd 2023 at the University of Konstanz.
