

How to search

If you are interested in knowing more about the universities in the European Reform University Alliance, the instructions below should help you navigate the university webpages.

Courses	Description of how to find the relevant info
General	<p>There isn't a separate course catalogue, but you can access them from the catalogue with the programmes. Under the link you can find the programs and courses in foreign languages. If you keep the English version, you will be able to find only the programs and the courses in foreign languages.</p> <p>Example:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Click on "BA Programmes in Foreign Languages" 2. Select a program 3. Click on "Part 1" or "Part 2" to see the courses offered within the program. To see more courses, select year and semester on the left

Research centers	Select the 'Departments and Centers' page and find the centers listed at the bottom of the page
Projects	Description of how to find the relevant info
General → Projects of NBU (Bulgarian version)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Open the main page and find below 'Projects of NBU' (only available on the Bulgarian version of the main page). Then you can go through the different categories of projects and search with keywords from the lists of projects. Once you have opened a specific category of project, you can also specify more you search by selecting from these filters 'status', 'funding', 'period', 'type of projects'

<p>Departments and Centers → Projects</p>	<p>or 'department'. On the pages of the project you can find the name of the leader but there are no contacts.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Go through the page 'Departments and Centers', select a research center from the list and from its page open 'Projects'. Contacts of the leaders are also available on the pages of the centers. - Go through the pages of the Research centers and open their own websites where you can find information about their project that is not available on the website of NBU. There are websites only of two of the research centres (Bulgarian Institute of Egyptology and Institute for Advanced Physical Studies" (IAPS)).

<p>General</p> <p>Departments → Publications ex. Political science → Publications (Bulgarian version)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Go to the main page and write 'publications' in the search window. Then you can filter by choosing from a list with categories - Go through the pages of the Departments and open 'Publications' pages if there are ones - Go through the listed publications by hand
<p>People</p>	<p>Description of how to find the relevant info</p>
<p>People working in research</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Open the research page of the NBU website, enter a keyword and go through the results by hand in order to find relevant people. - Go through the research centers by hand or search for names and contacts(ex. CERMES, Bulgarian Institute of Egyptology, Institute for Advanced Physical Studies" (IAPS))

<p>Courses</p>	<p>Description of how to find the relevant info</p>
<p>Course catalogue (search)</p>	<p>Enter one or more keywords. You have the option of filtering for the semester, the course type, the language of instruction, the</p>

	time, the rhythm and the day.
Course catalogue (overview)	Select a level of studies (e.g. bachelor's), then select a study program. You can now browse the modules and courses in the selected semester.
Research centers	Description of how to find the relevant info
Research institutions (without departmental research centers)	Go through the list by hand
Finding departmental centers	Select a faculty → click on “research” → if there are (departmental) research institutions connected to the faculty, they should be listed now
Projects	Description of how to find the relevant info
General (German version)	Search for project title/keyword and/or search for the last name of someone working on the project and/or search for an institution and/or filter for an institution (filtering for an institution is only available in the German version)
General (English version)	Search for project title/keyword or search for the last name of someone working on the project
Publications	Description of how to find the relevant info
General	Search for title/keyword and/or search for author and/or filter for institution
People	Description of how to find the relevant info
People working in research	Go through the list by hand or search for a last name or search for an institution. If you are looking for people working in specific fields and you don't know their names, use publications to find people who have published works in your field of interest.

General	Go to study.ruc page and firstly choose the wanted semester, at the green button beneath "Select Semester". Afterwards scroll down and press the green button "Search in all activity for *chosen semester*", then write the wanted search word and press enter. You will here be able to see all the wanted courses with that search word in the chosen semester.

General	Go to the forskning.ruc page, search for the wanted word and then press enter. To change language (Danish or English), press the globe in the right upper corner.

General	Go to the forskning.ruc page, search for the wanted word and then press enter. To change language (Danish or English), press the globe in the right upper corner.
Publications	Description of how to find the relevant info
General	Also called 'Research output'. Go to the forskning.ruc page, search for the wanted word and then press enter. To change language (Danish or English), press the globe in the right upper corner.

General	Also called 'Profiles' Go to the forskning.ruc page, search for the wanted word and then press enter. To change language (Danish or English), press the globe in the right upper corner.

General	Go to www.univ-paris8.fr webpage (only available in French version) and select the column <i>Études&Diplômes</i> , then select by hand the level of studies and the desired degree and click the link at the bottom of

	<p>the page (in the purple box). This link leads to the webpage of the UFR who is responsible for the desired program. Then, the courses (according to the level of studies) are usually at the column of <i>Offre de formation</i> or <i>Formation</i>.</p>
Research Units	Description of how to find the relevant info
General	<p>Go to the homepage of Paris 8 www.univ-paris8.fr and select the column <i>Recherche&Création</i>. Then, at the second column <i>Laboratoires de recherche</i> click on <i>Les unités de recherche (UR)</i> and <i>Les unités mixtes de recherche (UMR)</i>. You can select the desired research unit and see the relevant information.</p> <p>For more information, click the link at the bottom of the page (in the purple box). This link leads to the webpage of the specific Research Unit, which offers more details on its activity and members.</p>
Projects	Description of how to find the relevant info
	<p>Go to the homepage of Paris 8 www.univ-paris8.fr and select the column <i>Recherche&Création</i>. Then, at the third column <i>Projets et Événements Structurants</i> click on the desired project. For more information, click the link at the bottom of the page (in the purple box). This link leads to the webpage of the specific project, which offers more details.</p>

General	<p>Most publications are located at the webpage of each research unit.</p> <p>A number of publications by Paris 8 researchers are online on the internal HAL portal. You can also go to the main webpage of Paris 8 and select the column <i>Recherche&Création</i>. At the bottom of the page, click on <i>Archives ouvertes des publications scientifiques (HAL)</i> and then click the link at the bottom of the purple box on the right. This link leads to a website</p>

	<p>where you can search the wanted publication and author.</p> <p>At the bottom of the same column <i>Recherche&Création</i> click on <i>Presses universitaires de Vincennes (PUV)</i> and then click the link at the bottom of the purple box on the right. This link leads to a website where you can search the wanted publication and author.</p>

General	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Main webpage (only available in Greek version) 2. First option in the Menu→ ΣΠΟΥΔΕΣ (Studies) 3.
