# **Executive Summary**

This document identifies the existing and potential convergences in research and innovation infrastructure and resources available in ERUA. It identifies specific connecting possibilities in scientific fields (such as European studies, behavioral studies, marine biology and ecology) and on topics (such as decision-making, digitization and datafication, globalization, postcolonialism, multilingualism, memory studies, migration). The document attempts to chart the barriers to sharing resources. It summarizes the results form a survey among research unit leaders across the Alliance regarding their interest in collaborating and sharing as well as regarding any barriers to doing so. It also offers an action plan for tackling these obstacles.













# 1. Introduction

### Rationale

The goal of this document is to identify the existing and potential convergences in research and innovation resources and infrastructures available across ERUA. At the same time as these convergences are charted, the document suggests some connecting possibilities for joined research, innovation and partnership (Part 2 "Convergences"). In addition, we attempt to anticipate barriers to collaboration and sharing (Part 3 "Barriers") and develop an action plan for tackling them (Part 4 "Action Plan").

This "Assessment and Action Plan" serves as the first step towards the "Infrastructure sharing procedures document", the document which will define the procedures for sharing and connecting our resources (Deliverable 6.3 to be produced by our Working Package).

# Methodology

After creating a "Map of the Research and Innovation Resources and Infrastructures" available across the Alliance (organized into 375 research units), over the summer of 2022 we made it available to research unit leaders along with a brief survey regarding interest in collaborating with ERUA researchers and sharing infrastructure within the Alliance as well as on any obstacles and restrictions to doing so. The goal was twofold:

- to gauge researchers' sense of the possibilities and limitations for collaboration and sharing
- to give researchers a chance to "see themselves on the map" of the research units in the Alliance as well as to modify the information about the units under their leadership.

Given the timeframe of our process which necessitated a survey during the summer months we anticipated a low participation rate. Indeed, we received responses from 23 research unit leaders (some of them in charge of more than one research unit). We have used this data in writing this document, especially the section of "Barriers to sharing" (section 4). For the moment, only NBU, UKON and UP8 information have been received, the UAegean and RUC response will allow to update the action plan.

The process of creating ERUA's "Map of the Research and Innovation Resources and Infrastructures" (updated version attached as Appendix 1) and its subsequent analysis readily suggested areas of common interests, convergence potential and connecting possibilities.















The preliminary action plan for realizing this potential (section 4) is based on discussions and synergies between our Working Package and Working Package 2 ("Engagement strategy for the areas research & innovation"). As already indicated, this aspect of the current document will be subject to further discussion, refinement and revision in order to establish and communicate relevant processes and procedures (terms and conditions) across the partner universities for connecting partners' existing resources and infrastructures (Deliverable 6.3, due by the end of 2022).















The analysis of ERUA's "Map of the Research and Innovation Resources and Infrastructures" complements the rough picture of the research strengths of our member institutions based on Scopus publication data as summarized and critiqued by ERUA Work Package 2 "Reimagining Higher Education" in 2021 (D2.3 "What is a Reform University Today?", 21-27). That report found the highest publication numbers by ERUA researchers in the fields of the biological and computer and information sciences. It also reported relatively high numbers in the fields of cognitive science, psychology and sociology as well as in economics and business. The report emphasized shared foci of publication activity among researchers at UKON, UAegean, RUC and UP8. (NBU's publication data was difficult analyze because of the smaller absolute numbers and the greater variation with them.)

As shown by the data tabulated below in this section, the research fields in which the most research and innovation resources are concentrated at the Alliance level do not align perfectly with those identified as most active in publication by last year's report. (That is to be expected, since Scopus publication data has well-known shortcomings in counting humanities and social sciences publications, especially Eastern European ones.)

For the purposes of identifying existing and potential convergences as well as envisioning merging and connecting possibilities, the data analyzed as a result of our mapping exercise complements with some finer-grain detail what we already know about the social science orientation of the Alliance as a whole.

Using the data primarily presented under the "SCIENTIFIC AREAS" and "KEY THEMES" rubrics in the "Updated Map of the Research and Innovation Resources and Infrastructures" (Appendix 1) we sorted the 375 research units into fourteen scientific area groupings. These groupings reflect the most frequently found transdisciplinary collaborations among and within ERUA research units, indeed within individual ERUA researchers' interests (as mapped in detail in Appendix 1). Indeed, most research units are represented under more than one scientific area grouping below.

What emerges are several areas of concentrated research and innovation interest across the whole Alliance with clear potential for connection and/or merging.

The scientific areas of sociology, psychology (esp. social), behavior studies (incl. psychoeconomics) and gender studies are object of investigation and innovation at the highest number of ERUA research units, with all the fields strongly represented in each member institution.

The computer sciences and mathematics (incl. applied mathematical disciplines) are the second strongest grouping in terms of absolute number of research units wholly or partly dedicated to them, with special strength in equipment and breadth of subfields at UAegean and UKON. Connecting possibilities appear particularly strong in the fields of data science, artificial intelligence, virtual reality and the "Internet of Things".

The broad grouping of cultural studies (incl. the more traditional humanities of history and literary studies) is well represented across the Alliance with connecting possibilities especially in the field of European studies and on the topics of migration, postcolonialism, memory and commemoration.

## 3. Barriers

The responses to our survey did not indicate awareness among research unit leaders about legal barriers to infrastructures sharing (incl. regarding legal coordination). Apart from the software license agreements **no specific barriers** were mentioned.

Many respondents emphasized that ethical standards and best research practices need to be observed by any collaborators and guest researchers.

One respondent expected that a contract agreement between research units would have to be drafted if a long-term partnership were to be established. Another suggested that set data ownership parameters would have to be part of such an agreement. As is natural, several respondents emphasized that any sharing of resources and infrastructure is subject to approval by the hosting research unit of guest scholars' research plans.

However, more input is needed on this issue given the great diversity of research unit types and the low response rate of this survey.

Although most respondents indicated strong interest in collaborating and sharing resources related to research and innovation, several expressed skepticism about realistic prospect (one respondent at UP8 and another at UKON). The greatest obstacle remains the lack of awareness of the possibilities ERUA has already created and those possible in the future as a result of the Re:ERUA initiative.

In addition, as the ERUA membership ranges geographically across the European continent, opportunities for physical mobility and virutal connection between researchers will be required. Of course, the many ERUA reserch units in the Human Sciences may need to share data and human capital rather than equipment, a scenario in which virtual connection might be an adequate option.

The procedures for sharing research resources will be done on a "case-by-case" basis, according to the links that will be created between laboratories and will be supported by the research support services to supervise this sharing.

As with all international collaborations, there is a **linguistic dfference issue**, so it is natural to expect that connections will be limited by the availability of a comon language between researchers.

As far as the potential for federation and/or merging, the lack of common research structures on a European scale which could serve as models make it a more distant prospect at this stage.













# 4. Action Plan for Tackling Barriers

Since specific barriers were not identified, it is incumbent upon us to solicit information from legal and research support offices at ERUA member level about potential **obstacles** to sharing resources and infrastructure. This we intend to do prior to creating an "Infrastructure sharing procedures document", the document which will define the procedures for sharing and connecting our resources (Deliverable 6.3 to be produced by our Working Package).


In addition, a **Network of Research Operational Support Offices** across the Alliance is being set up by Re:ERUA Work Package 2 "Engagement strategy for the areas of research and innovation". This network is to have the tasks of tackling day to day obstacles at legal and administrative levels (local, national and European) and supporting institutioncommunity partnerships on all aspects of engaged research and funding. This Network can and should be a key factor in facilitating collaboration and sharing of resources and infrastructures.

The creation of virtual and physical meeting spaces dedicated to joint research initiatives as part of the activities of Re:ERUA Working Package 6 is designed to help overcome the geographical barriers between researchers in different countries (Deliverable 6.6, due by the end of 2022).

Finally, it is clear **information campaign among researchers** will be necessary in order to create awareness of the great potential for research collaboration and sharing of resources and infrastructure within ERUA. Ideally, such a campaign will coincide with the launching of the digital database which will contain the "Map of the Research and Innovation Resources and Infrastructures" (Deliverable 6.4, due by the end of 2022). Again, the Network of Research Operational Support Offices will be a great help in this respect.






