## **Main Research Objective**

The cluster's main aim is to advance research on multilingual language policies and multicultural cohesion, addressing challenges of the data-driven era and enhancing societal progress through effective intercultural communication in transdisciplinary professional contexts, such as educational settings and other socially relevant fields.

## Objectives:

- 1. Technology and Data Management: Enable technology and data in social systems to enhance organizational efficiency and foster societal development.
- 2. Language Policies: Evaluate language policies and practices in education and administration across ERUA universities to promote linguistically inclusive intercultural communication and digital support in educational settings.
- 3. Language for Academic Purposes (LAP) and Language for Specific Purposes (LSP) Teaching: Investigate how AI and other digital tools impact the teaching and learning of LAP and LSP, focusing on new learner needs, and enhancing domain-specific knowledge, transferable soft skills, and digital competencies for diverse intercultural and multilingual professional contexts.
- 4. Multilingual Terminology: Conduct data-driven research on multilingual terminology in transdisciplinary fields to support the understanding of specialized knowledge-building mechanisms and their linguistic representation across languages, ensuring consistent intercultural communication in professional environments.
- 5. Intercultural Digital Communication: Promote research on intercultural digital communication in transdisciplinary professional environments to enhance collaboration, mutual understanding, digital innovation and respect for cultural diversity.

#### **Main Research Outcome**

- 1. Joint Research Publications and Presentations: Presenting research findings in internationally indexed publications and oral presentations at international scientific conferences; disseminating results to a broader audience through education-related websites and media.
- 2. Development of a Multilingual Term base: Creation of a freely accessible multilingual term base hosted on an open-access platform. This will promote consistent intercultural communication and serve educational purposes by enhancing domain-specific knowledge building and language learning.

- 3. PhD Student Involvement: Engagement of PhD students, fostering the development of young researchers. The initial research cluster includes 3 R1 researchers, with plans to invite and involve additional PhD students in future cluster activities.
- 4. Research Project Proposal Submission: Preparation and submission of a joint research project proposal under the ERASMUS+ program.
- 5. Collaboration with Research Infrastructures: Cooperation with research infrastructures such as CLARIN ERIC (Research Infrastructure for Language Resources and Technologies) and its national consortia: CLARIN-LT (Lithuania), CLARIN-BG (Bulgaria), CLARIN-ES (Spain) and other national consortia.
- 6. Collaboration with Research Associations and Research Centres: Cooperation with research associations, such as GERAS (English for Specific Purposes Study and Research Group) and EAFT (European Association for Terminology), and Research Centre for AI-Driven Digital Content Technology.
