Provisional List of Accepted and Rejected Proposals

As stated in the 2025 Call for Interuniversity Educational Innovation Projects within the ERUA Strategic Alliance of Universities, for the 2025-2026 and 2026-2027 academic years:

Once the application submission period has closed, a Resolution will be issued containing the provisional list of accepted and rejected applications, along with the reasons for rejection. Applicants whose projects have been rejected will have a period of ten (10) working days, starting from the day following the publication of the Resolution, to appeal the provisional list or, where applicable, to amend or complete the required documentation.

For projects involving ULPGC (Task 2.7 Leader), appeals and/or amendments must be submitted via the ULPGC Electronic Office, using the procedure “Solicitud de Proyecto de Innovación Educativa” For projects not involving ULPGC, the relevant documentation should be submitted to the coordinator at the applicant’s home university, who will then forward it to the ULPGC coordinator after the ten-day appeal period.

Reason for Rejection

1. ONLY FOR PROJECTS INVOLVING ULPGC: The budget must allocate 10% of the funding to the 2025 financial year (noting that, for this year, only expenses under Chapter 2 may be budgeted), 50% to the 2026 financial year (only expenses under Chapter 6 may be budgeted), and 40% to the 2027 financial year, in accordance with Article 6.1.
2. The project does not comply with Article 2.4.1: The number of Educational Innovation Project (PIE) members per university must be **no fewer than two** and no more than ten.
